## Dear Sanjeev,

**A.** Wet fur and muddy paws can cause a lot of fungal and yeast infections in pets. The infections may also result in a lot of discomfort. So it is important to keep the fur dry and clean. A hairdryer or a room heater can be used to dry your pet's damp fur.



Dry shampoos and paper towels can be used to clean him instead of giving him a bath every day.



Q. My house has a few lizards. I don't care about them but my sister screams when she sees one. What should I do?
